

2007 IAAI Election and Voting Procedures

In the 2007 Annual General Election the IAAI will utilize the “Electronic Voting Process” which was initiated in 2006. For those who did not participate in the election process last year the process is simple and user friendly allowing every member to participate in the direction of the organization. The General Election includes election of Officers and Directors along with proposed Constitutional & by Laws changes The Election Committee has established the 2007 voting cycle this year to begin on **April 01, 2007 09:00 am and will end on May 01, 2007 at 11:00 am Pacific Coast time.** For those who do not chose to vote prior to attending the ATC in Victoria, BC Canada, a polling both will be available on Tuesday morning from 07:00 am until 11:00 am.

The voting procedure is as follows. Access the member’s only section of the IAAI website www.firearson.com and click on the Election tab. After entering the required information the system will email you a random Pin # for use in Voting. The Pin # will be sent to your established email address reflected on your IAAI profile. **If your profile is not up to date or if you have not provided a current email address, please update your profile prior to requesting a pin #.**

Upon receipt of the Pin #, return to the member’s only section on the IAAI website, click on the Election button and enter the pin # and cast your votes as you desire. Use of the Pin # is mandatory for voting.

For those who have questions or wish to discuss the proposed Constitution & by Laws proposals, we encourage you to utilize the Forum section on the member’s only section of the IAAI web site. Should you have specific technical questions on a proposal, or if you encounter any difficulties with the voting process please contact the International office and your question or concerns will be directed to the proper authority.
