Preparing Expert Reports

David J. Icove, CFEI

Writing Expert Reports: Properly documenting a fire incident is essential in both private industry and the public sector. Fire reports often serve as a basis of developing action plans for preventing future incidents in the private sector, and reports by fire investigators must be carefully prepared in accordance with uniform guidelines and professional standards to be useful in prosecution of suspected criminals. This presentation will offer time-tested advice on key elements to be included in fire incident reports. Included in the program are helpful report preparation checklists and discussion of essential materials in *NFPA 921*, *NFPA 1033* and *ASTM* standards.

Presenter: Dr. David Icove is an internationally recognized forensic fire engineering expert with over 40 years of experience. He is co-author of ***Combating Arson-for-Profit***, the leading textbook on the crime of economic arson, and he is co-author of ***Forensic Fire Scene Reconstruction***, a popular reference for fire investigators. He has also served as a principal member of the *NFPA 921* Technical Committee on Fire Investigations since 1992. As a retired career Federal Law Enforcement Agent, he is

presently a Research Professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville; an Adjunct Faculty member at the Department of Fire Protection Engineering, University of Maryland. Dr. Iove is a Registered Professional Engineer.
