## 2012 South Region Basic Fire Investigation Course

This is a basic fire investigation course designed to provide the student with the knowledge through lecture and hands on exercises the ability to understand the investigation processes. The course will cover these aspects by incorporating nationally recognized standards, reference materials, and guidelines in the curriculum.

All class room lectures will be hosted by the Camden County Fire Academy, 420 Woodbury-Turnersville Road, Blackwood , New Jersey. Classes will commence on March 20, 2012 and run consecutive Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 1900 to 2200 hours until June 21, 2012. There will be two Saturday practical exercises held, one in April and the other in June and will run from 8am to 4pm.

The fee for the course is \$400.00 for members and \$450.00 for non-members (Note: the non-member fee includes a one year membership in the New Jersey Chapter). Fees include all course materials, student text books and lunch on the two practical day sessions.
